

DS4SEQ to hold their own Gold Coast Daylight Saving Referendum

On Sunday 23 May, the Daylight Saving for South East Queensland Party will be holding its own referendum on the Gold Coast on Daylight Saving in South East Queensland.

"We will be letting people have their say on whether Daylight Saving should be introduced into South East Queensland," Daylight Saving for South East Queensland Party Leader, Jason Furze, said.

Mr Furze said that last month, Premier Anna Bligh asked her caucus to return to their electorates to talk to their constituents and gain feedback on Daylight Saving.

"As Labor has only four elected members on the Gold Coast, not all residents have had the chance to have their say, so we are giving them that opportunity. This is what democracy is all about," Mr Furze said.

"It's a bit impromptu, so it will be interesting to see the reaction," Mr Furze said.

"Once we have finalised the result of our poll, we will forward it on to the Premier for her consideration," Mr Furze said.

"We will also be using this opportunity to encourage people to have their say on the Queensland Government feedback website www.getinvolved.qld.gov.au," Mr Furze said.
